## ORDINANCE NO. 2018-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRING BRANCH, TEXAS REDUCING THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT ON KNIBBE ROAD BETWEEN FM 311 AND US HWY 281 TO 20 MPH.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Spring Branch, Texas finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of its citizens to reduce vehicle speed limits on Knibbe Rd; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission further finds that the reduction in speed limits will potentially prevent vehicle accidents and pedestrian injuries; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to reduce the posted speed limit from 30 MPH to 20 MPH on Knibbe Road; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRING BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. The posted speed limit will be 20 MPH

Extent

Knibbe Road between FM 311 and US Hwy 281.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor or his designee is directed to erect and place signs designating the posted speed limit as 20 MPH.

<u>Section 4.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent and duration of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 5. Any person who shall intentionally, knowingly, recklessly, or with criminal negligence, violate any provision of this Ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and,

upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$500. Each violation shall constitute a separate offense.

<u>Section 6</u>. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or

the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Spring Branch, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption hereof, as provided by law.
