A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRING BRANCH, TEXAS EXTENDING MAYOR MAYER'S DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER; ORDERING THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN BUSINESSES DEEMED NON-ESSENTIAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Mayor of the City of Spring Branch, Texas issued that certain Declaration of Local Disaster by Proclamation of the Mayor of the City of Spring Branch, Texas effective March 23, 2020 (the "Declaration"); and

WHEREAS, the Declaration activated the City's Emergency Response Plan and reserved for the Mayor, all the rights to exercise all emergency powers as are available to address the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, the Declaration further authorized the Mayor to update the regulations enacted by the Declaration as the Declaration Regarding Public and Private Gatherings (the "Declaration Regulations"); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it will reduce the possibility of exposure to disease, control risk, and promote the health safety and welfare of the City of Spring Branch to close certain businesses for which social distancing protocols are either ineffective or impracticable, including nail salons, barbershops and similar businesses.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRING BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. The Mayor's Declaration of a Local Disaster is hereby extended until rescinded by the Mayor, or as amended by the City Commission.
- 2. Nail salons, hair salons, barber shops, beauty shops, and any other business providing hair cutting or styling, hair removal, makeup application, skin and nail care, or similar cosmetic services shall close and remain closed at all times during the term of the Declaration, as the same may be continued by the City Commission.
- 3. To the extent necessary to enforce the terms of the Mayor's Order, the Declaration Regulations are updated to include the regulations included in this Resolution.
- 4. This Resolution shall be effective as of 7:00 P.M. on Tuesday, March 31, 2020.
