

**Meeting was held at Fire Station #6, 9850 FM 311, Spring Branch, Tx 78070**


- 1) Call to order at 6:30 PM. Present were Mayor James Mayer, Commissioner Brad Hockman, Commissioner David Dobbins, and City Clerk Terrie Barnes.**
  - a) Pledge of Allegiance.**
- 2) Mayor Mayer asked if anyone had reviewed the July minutes. Commissioner Hockman moved to waive reading aloud the minutes for the July 2025 regular meeting, second by Commissioner Dobbins. The July minutes were unanimously approved. No opposed.**
- 3) The Financial report for the month ending July 2025 was read by Mayor Mayer.**
- 4) Discuss and consider approval of outdoor lighting application for Lennar Simmons Valley South Entrance. Lennar failed to submit lumens, color and information on the back lit south entrance sign that borders GVTC substation. Mayor Mayer will request additional information from Lennar and if lighting is compliant with Lighting Ordinance he will approve. Also mentioning the sign/monument's water feature was scaled back and will be using recycled water.**
- 5) Discuss and consider 2025 proposed No New Revenue Tax Rate of \$0.068239 per \$100 or Voter Approve Tax Rate of \$0.080941 per \$100. All approved proposed No New Revenue**
