September 13, 2022**


Meeting held at Fire Station #6, 9850 FM 311, Spring Branch

- 1) Call to order at 6:30 PM. Present were Mayor Mayer, Commissioner Hockman, Commissioner Dobbins, and City Clerk.**
 - a) Pledge of Allegiance**
- 2) The Minutes of August 9, 2022, regular meeting were not available.**
- 3) Public comments & questions:**
 - a) What comprises animal control cost? – Services provided by the Sheriff's Department under an interlocal agreement with Comal County.**
 - b) Where can one find info on the City Limits & jurisdiction of the City? – See Comal County GIS online.**
 - c) What is the new development/subdivision? – Lennar Homes is in planning and permitting stage for a subdivision outside the city limits. Permitting is by Comal County and TCEQ.**
 - d) Traffic accidents on Spring Branch Road, at the curves about 2.5 miles west of US Hwy 281 were reported. What can the City of Spring Branch do? – Mayor Mayer took suggestions from the public in attendance. Mayor will contact the Comal Sheriff's department to request more regular enforcement of the 35 mph speed limit. Also, Mayor will consult with legal counsel about concerns and issues related to this curve and damage caused by vehicles.**
- 4) Mayor Mayer read the financial report for the month ending August, 31, 2022.**

- 5) Mayor Mayer reviewed the Proposed Budget for fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, unchanged from the Budget presented at the August 9, 2022 regular meeting. Mayor Mayer made the motion to approve the FYE 2023 budget. Commissioner Dobbins, seconded, and it was approved by unanimous vote.**
- 6) Mayor Mayer reviewed the Truth in Taxation documents and the proposed property tax rate for 2022, as discussed in the Public Hearing held on September 6, 2022. The proposed rate is \$0.084499 per \$100 valuation. Commissioner Hockman made the motion to approve the \$0.084499 rate, seconded by Commissioner Dobbins. The rate was adopted by unanimous vote.**
- 7) There being no further business or public comment, meeting adjourned at 7:11 pm.**
